

## **LOCAL INDIE ARTISTS PERFORM AT THE EGG**

Columbia Arts Team presents the 3<sup>rd</sup> annual Capital Area Indie Fest on Saturday, October 6 at The Egg. Indie rock station WEXT (Exit 97.7) sponsors the event.

Indie Fest features local artists of all types who have an established fan base, and are performing and recording regularly. The artists' music will be featured in the weeks before the show on WEXT. Now in its third year, Indie Fest has showcased many local artists who don't often get to show what they can do in a world-class venue with great sound and lighting. Audiences discover new favorites they've never heard before, and the artists pick up new fans.

“We’re thrilled to be working together once again with WEXT,” proclaimed Christina Dellea, CAT co-founder. “We’re especially excited that EXT’s own Dave Michaels is on board to MC the show.”

Special guests at Indie Fest will be Best New Artist winner Jodi Shaw, the Exit Factor winner, and Hudson singer/songwriter Sandy McKnight. Along with McKnight's own songs, he'll share the stage with Liv Cummins and Christina Dellea, who will each perform a song from their respective CDs. Indie artists featured this year are Tor Loney, The City Never Sleeps, The Hearing Aides, High Bridge North, and Robert Ruark.

The event is a fundraiser for Columbia Arts Team (CAT), a 501 (c) 3 not-for-profit performing arts company. CAT showcases new, original musicians, writers and performers, as well as brings arts programs into area schools.
